APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND SELECTION CRITERIA

Requirement for All Applicants:

An applicant must be an **official matriculated SDSU student** at the time of application.

Requirements for *Group 1* Students:

1. An applicant must be **enrolled in Japanese** with Letter Grade in both **Fall 2021** and **Spring 2022** and receive **C or above**. If C- or below is received, the Selection Committee will rescind its positive recommendation and notify the universities in Japan.
2. If an applicant misses **25% or more** of a Japanese language class at SDSU, the Selection Committee will rescind its nomination, regardless of his/her course grade. **Three tardies will be counted as one absence**
3. An applicant must maintain the minimum **GPA of 2.75**. He/she is **required to submit the following transcript:** (A) an unofficial copy at the time of application, (B) unofficial copies submitted to Dr. Higurashi at the end of the Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 semesters, and (C) an OFFICIAL paper copy to the Study Abroad Office at the time of submitting your host school's application.
4. An applicant must make arrangements with two faculty members so that their letters of reference will be sent directly to Dr. Higurashi electronically. Please ask them to use the **Reference Form** provided.)
5. An applicant must have a favorable interview with the Selection Committee.

JAPANESE MAJORS AND MINORS

Requirements for Group 2 Students:

1. If not enrolled in Japanese currently, an applicant must have successfully taken at least two semesters of Japanese at SDSU in the past and earned C or above in all Japanese courses.
2. An applicant must maintain the minimum **GPA of 2.75**. He/she is **required to submit the following transcript:** (A) an unofficial copy at the time of application, (B) unofficial copies submitted to Dr. Higurashi at the end of the Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 semesters, and (C) an OFFICIAL paper copy to the Study Abroad Office at the time of submitting your host school's application.
3. An applicant must make arrangements with two faculty members so that their letters of reference will be sent directly to Dr. Higurashi electronically. (Please ask them to use the **Reference Form** provided.)
4. An applicant must have a favorable interview with the Selection Committee.
