



The language courses focus on helping students develop integrated language skills in the context of modern Korean society.

The lower division language courses can be used to fulfill the GE foreign language requirements.

All Korean courses are part of the curriculum for Asian and Pacific Studies and International Business.

In addition to general language courses, the Korean program offers a variety of culture courses including an overview of Korean history (Korean Civilization, KOR 321) and a closer look at contemporary Korean culture as reflected in the media (KOR 430). We also offer a practicum course in teaching Korean as a second language (KOR 490).

One Course (3 units total) selected from the following:

 Korean Civilization
- KOR 430/ASIAN 430
 Contemporary Korean Culture through Media
- KOR 496 Topics in Korean Studies

The Certificate demonstrates a high proficiency in the Korean language and a foundational understanding of Korean culture and history. It is designed to enhance students' job opportunities in Korea-related companies and employability in TESL to learners with a Korean background.
