The language courses focus on helping students develop integrated language skills in the context of modern Korean society.

The lower division language courses can be used to fulfill the GE foreign language requirements.

All Korean courses are part of the curricular for *Asian and Pacific Studies* and *International Business*.

In addition to general language courses, the Korean program offers a variety of culture courses including an overview of the Korean history (*Korean Civilization*, KOR 321) and a closer look at the contemporary Korean culture as reflected in the media (KOR 430), and Business Korean (KOR 331). We also offer an internship course and a practicum course in teaching Korean as a second language.

Our Korean courses meet the diverse needs of the San Diego community.

Korean Studies Certificate

The certificate requires 12 units to include:

- **Two courses** from **KOR 301** (Adv. Kor. I), **KOR 302** (Adv. Kor. II), **KOR 331** (Business Korean)
- **KOR 321** (Korean Civilization)
- **One course** from **KOR 430** (Contemporary Korean Culture through Media), **POL S 362** (Government and Politics of East Asia), or **REL S 345** (Religions of East Asia)

The Certificate declares a high proficiency in the Korean language and a foundational understanding of Korean culture and history. It is designed to enhance students' job opportunities in Korea-related companies and employability in TESL to learners with a Korean background.
